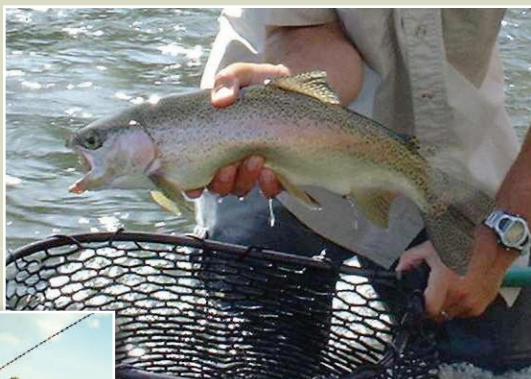

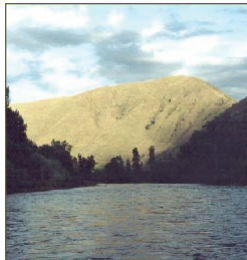


# The Yakima River



The Yakima River in Washington is the finest trout stream in the Evergreen State, offering great rainbow trout fishing, as well as the occasional cut-bow and cutthroat. The river starts at its source

high in the North Central Cascades and flows for miles and miles through lush forests—both pine and cottonwood—enters the farmlands of the Kittitas Valley, and floats through the famous Yakima River Canyon. It offers nearly 80 miles of prime catch and release only fly fishing.

is famous for its spring time caddis, PMD, PED, baetis, skwala stones, march browns, salmon fly and other hatches. The summer months are great for casting tight to the banks with your hopper or dry stone fly (this



is my favorite time on the YAK). Fall offers us great baetis hatches. Winter midge fishing can also be great for the die hards out there. All year long we'll nymph and throw the big ugly streamers to fool the trout.
